### **Old Business**

**Track Uniform Amendment:** Track uniforms came to \$5800 instead of \$5780 – Cory motioned to amend previous amount to \$5800 and the ability to come back and discuss it if further moderations were necessary. Patty – 2<sup>nd</sup>, Motion Carried.

1) **Craft Show Update:** Over 125 vendors were on hand (biggest ever) and only 2 that had signed up didn't show, but told us to keep the fee. Lunch went well and there was a lot of clothing sold and even more orders. Laurel didn't have the total available for profit.

2) **Business Memberships:** Laurel will start sending those out this week.

3) **Pizza Ranch Fundraiser:** Need to set a date. Cory volunteered to talk to them on Jan. 11 since he will be there for a SICL meeting. We need to know well in advance to advertise and get workers.

4) **Youth Basketball Tournaments:** Boys play on Jan. 21. There are currently 17 teams signed up (4<sup>th</sup> grade = 3, 5<sup>th</sup> grade = 7, 6<sup>th</sup> grade = 7). Girls will be Jan. 28 with 12 teams (4<sup>th</sup> grade = 2, 5<sup>th</sup> grade = 4, 6<sup>th</sup> grade = 6). Rhonda is working on a game schedule and getting helpers. She would like to pair up one adult and one student to ref each game. It also needs to be checked on about having janitors to clean up after the tournaments. It was brought up that there is an adult SICL alumni basketball game that may conflict with finding helpers on the 28<sup>th</sup>.

5) **AAU Volleyball Dates:** Beau was unaware of any dates that may have been set, but Carol may have some in the office for gym requests. [Note: he later received a text that the requested dates were Jan. 29, Feb. 5, and Mar. 4]

### *New Business*

- 1) **Winter Sports Concessions:** No real report. There seems to be a lot of empty spaces still on the sign up sheet at the concession stand.
- 2) **Old Fashioned Christmas 2017:** The city is potentially wanting to move Old Fashioned Christmas to “Christmas in July”. Laurel has already collected money for the winter craft show. It was discussed if whether or not the town council will actually shut down the tradition, but no one on the Chamber has stepped up to plan it as of yet. It will be discussed at the next town council meeting. Laurel plans to attend or send a letter.
- 3) **Scholarship Committee:** We need to appoint a committee to redo the scholarship essays and form, including how to score the applications. It was asked that we double check all applicants for the requirements of their parents being members before we read the essays since last year ran into that issue that one that was picked did not have parents that were members. Cory, Patty, and Heather agreed to look at the question and form. Laurel did not have a current copy, but said Karla R. should have one from last year to use as a starting point.
- 4) **Winter Sports Banquet:** There is no date set as of right now. It was discussed about having just one winter sports banquet instead of a separate one for wrestling. The dates will be set after the end of the seasons are known.
- 5) **Fish Fry:** The date has been set as March 3 to coincide with the dance showcase to helpfully bring people in.

- 1) **Track items:** Thank you for agreeing to purchase the uniforms and blocks and for amending the total.
- 2) **Youth Basketball:** Beau will double check on the janitors.
- 3) **SICL Meeting:** The SICL meeting next week will be where next year’s sports schedules will be set, so more information on that at the next meeting.
